

"GOD'S PLAN FOR ME WAS TO BE TRANSFORMED."

Every Saturday night, Pacific Garden Mission hold a Praise and **Testimony service where everyone** gathers together to hear testimonies of lives changed through Jesus Christ. Among the visitors in the audience are homeless men and women who came to PGM seeking more than just food and shelter. Their testimonies, followed by the Gospel, open hearts. Many will receive Christ and be born again in His light. Hope is then revealed to them through the programs they are inspired to enter, where the Word of God transforms their minds and hearts. With your help, we are spreading the light of Christ and changing lives.

SENORA

Senora frequently shares her story of transformation, of overcoming hardships and finding salvation. "I have been through a lot. I grew up in an alcoholic family. At the age of eight, I saw my dad murdered. At the age of thirteen I had been sexually abused by a family member. At the age of sixteen, I started using drugs to hide from the pain I was going through, pain inflicted upon me by my family. At the age of twenty, my mother died. I had three kids at the time. Growing up I had no one to show me love. My mother was there, but she was unable to show us

love because she was drunk all of the time."

After years of struggling with addiction, Senora reached a breaking point and knew she had to make a decision.

"At this point, I had nowhere to go. It was cold outside, and I was hungry. I just said to myself 'I can't do this anymore', and I asked God to show me what to do and where to go. I went to the police station and said I was homeless and hungry. I just wanted someplace that was safe where I could rest. They said there was only one place they could take me. That was Pacific Garden Mission."

Senora graduated the New Day addiction recovery program here and soon after got married. She now lives in her own apartment and often comes to the Mission on Saturday's to join in the church service. Arriving with nothing but the clothes on her back and a little hope, Senora is now content and filled with the spirit.

"I didn't know that God's plan for me was to be transformed." Senora told the crowd. "Get to know God. Build a relationship with Him, and I guarantee you will be a totally different person when you walk out of these doors. Please! If you need help, do not leave before that miracle comes."

Nothing speaks of hope to the hopeless more than seeing someone who once struggled so dearly, but is now living a fully functioning life in Christ. Once someone has decided to follow Jesus Christ and to begin a new life walking with Him, that person needs a family of believers to help them.

Helping someone completely rebuild their life can seem like a daunting undertaking, especially individually, but together we can help hundreds of people do just that. It wouldn't be possible without you.

As we look forward to what God has planned for us, let us remember that together we can accomplish great things for His glory.

NATHAN

With encouragement, prayer, and love, people who once had nothing but despair can become fully functioning followers of Christ with hope and a productive, stable life. Leadership at PGM prayerfully and intentionally makes the Mission a loving and nurturing environment to foster spiritual growth. On Saturdays, during our Praise and Testimony Service, we sing hymns and worship through song. Nathan Tanner many times helps lead in the service. He also frequently shares his testimony to the homeless here.

"It didn't take me long to give up drinking because when you have Christ, it is easy to give that stuff up. You can fight so hard in a recovery or AA program, but if it is not about Christ, it is not going to work. If you have Christ, it is going to work. It doesn't matter what kind of addiction you may have because it doesn't stand up to the Lord Jesus. He set me free from drinking and a lot of lustful behaviors. I joined the Bible program here and fell in love with the ministry because they are shining a bright Gospel light. We

preach the Gospel three or four times a day, and I am happy with serving Christ. Only the Lord can make you happy, and there is no joy like serving the Lord. If you are here tonight and thinking about giving your life to Christ, don't think about it anymore; run up here when Pastor Phil gives the invitation. Nothing bad will happen from trying to have a relationship with God."

Men and women like Nathan and Senora are lights to those around them. They are living proof of the power of God and the hope and future possible to those still in darkness. Like many of the graduates of our discipleship programs, they are busy fulfilling the Great Commission. God is working here every day, and without your loving support, this would not be possible. *Thank You.*

RENEWAL FOR TODAY AND BEYOND

As the New Year arrives many people think about changes they can make in the coming year. For most, these changes involve external things: weight loss, exercise, running, healthy eating, etc. The biggest changes occur not on the outside, however, but the inside. Romans 12:2 reads: "And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God." "Transformation" in Greek is metamorpho, or metamorphosis, the process of the caterpillar becoming a butterfly. This perfectly illustrates what we know is true: gradual, intentional change on the inside leads to lasting change on the outside. Ephesians 4:22 tells us: "That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts." The old man here represents our old ways of living, those aspects we want to change—but how? Ephesians 4:23 tells us: "Be renewed in the spirit of your mind." Some ask, how are people at the Mission that came from such difficult situations changing? The answer is by the renewing of their minds. When I read Senora's testimony, I am amazed where she came from, but I see the outward change because she has focused on renewing her mind. She is here every

week involved in the ministry with her husband.

How do we renew our minds?

- **1. Replace.** Replace old habits of the mind with new. What do we read and watch and listen to? If our minds are full of romance novels, violent movies, and cursing, no wonder we struggle with lust and anger.
- 2. Renounce. In a story about forgiveness Jesus says, "Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellow-servant, even as I had pity on thee? And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him." Matthew 18:33–34. If we live without forgiveness in our hearts, we open ourselves up to being given over to our tormentors
