

THANK YOU FOR A NEW DAY!


Many of the men and women who have come to Pacific Garden Mission for support, oftentimes with a crippling addiction in tow, have shared how despite their successful completion of other treatment programs in the past, they were still left with a spiritual void in their hearts. Sadly, this eventually led them back into the grips of their addiction. Their minds may have been filled with useful knowledge, but their hearts were left unbearably empty.

Our New Day Addictions Recovery Program is deliberately and prayerfully designed to interweave both Biblical teachings and practical addictions recovery education. The balance between the two makes our New Day Addictions Program unique, and it's with YOUR help that men and women are finding both sobriety and spiritual freedom in Jesus Christ here at PGM.

"I struggled with crack cocaine and alcohol for about 15 years. I was the type of addict that would get paid on Fridays, then go home and give my wife the money we needed to take care of the bills, plus a little money for her pocket. But the rest . . . I would take that and get high. Then, I worked odds and ends jobs to make more money so I could keep getting high during the week. My wife saw my life going down

the drain. She saw how my body and my health were declining. And things I needed, or our future plans I wanted for us... she saw those could never happen with my addiction. My wife and I finally decided to separate until God changed some things in my life.

"My brother told me about the program here. He was in the Bible program at PGM years ago. When I was struggling in my addiction, he would encourage me and say if I wanted God to change my life, if I wanted a great life ... a spiritual life, then I should get into the Bible program at PGM. My brother would say 'I promise you, I promise your life will change.' But I didn't listen to him.

"What really led me here to Pacific Garden Mission is one night, I was asleep, and the Lord showed me a vision. He came to me in my sleep. I believe that was the Holy Spirit, and He said to just leave everything. I was going through my addiction, and I still had that hurt from leaving my wife and grandbabies. That was ok though

because I believe God had another plan for me, and I truly believe PGM was part of the plan.

18th of 2020, when I first came here to Pacific Garden Mission and rang the front doorbell. A lady came to the door. I didn't know who she was, and I was asking how I could get in. The woman on security said I had to go around to the men's entrance, and if no one was at the gate, to wait until they got back from lunch. My plan then was to get back on the subway and go back to the neighborhood, but I don't think I would have made it back here alive. As I started walking away, she said,

'No, don't leave!' in a concerned and authoritative way that showed she cared. As I left, I heard her voice in my head asking me to stay over and over. So, I turned around and went into Pacific Garden Mission. I truly believe God spoke through her that day.

"I just thank God for what He is doing right now because if it had not been for this New Day program and the teachers and preachers here, I probably wouldn't be alive. There have been times in a New Day class when my mind starts to drift away, and the teacher will say 'Erving! We are still in the classroom, and whatever you are thinking, you talk about *that*. And before we leave this class, we are going to make sure that God fixes it.'

"The support you get out of the program and the classes here . . . it's amazing. They are not just working for a check; they are working for the Spirit of God. They want to see you clean and successful in life. I am so glad those worldly things are out of my life, and I want to be totally honest—not just with myself now, but also with the Lord. I am looking forward to finishing the New Day program and going into the New Life Program. My whole attitude has changed . . . I thank God He has given me the desire to just stay put.

"I'm excited about the new me. I think differently—I know I talk differently—and I feel like I can be successful in this. This program here is what I actually needed. I have the opportunity to escape the worldly things and get into the Word of God. I used to say that I knew Jesus was

going to fix it for me, but now I believe He fixed it.

"I talked to my brother and told him where I was. He said, 'That's a good thing. If I can do it, you can do it!' He is a pastor of a church now. He said not to worry about anything I left behind . . . just focus on Jesus. He said everything I need—and even everything I want—is in Jesus . . . right here at Pacific Garden Mission. Everything he told me, in those exact words, was right."

During his testimony, Erving mentioned going through several outside treatment regimens. None were able to keep him sober, and it wasn't until he opened his heart to God that he was able to truly surrender. What a hundred self-help books and treatment programs can teach does not take root and grow into steadfast life-changing knowledge until the emptiness is filled. It is only the love of Jesus Christ that can fill broken and empty hearts, and that's exactly what your help is leading these hurting hearts to. You are helping to fulfill the Great Commission every day. Thank you!
